Genesis 37:3-8, 17b-22, 26-34; 50:15-21 *Jacob's Sons*

Luke 6:27-35 *Love for Enemies*

If you haven't done so, take a moment to read the passages in Genesis (noted above) to become familiar with or to remind yourself of Joseph's story.

Joseph was his father's favorite, and this place of privilege made him think of himself as better than his brothers. Who are those who occupy a place of privilege in the world today? From where does their sense of entitlement come?

Although he was flawed, Joseph did have dreams that others did not think were of any importance. Whose dreams are going unheard or unnoticed today?

Pastor Ele tells a personal story of having to leave her homeland because she was unable to find work there. Upon every attempt to return home, she was rejected for having left. She finally gained a freedom she wasn't even seeking when she sought to understand and forgive those who had hurt her. How is her story like Joseph's?
